### Lunch

Lunch from home every day, that does not need to be heated or kept in a refrigerator. Campers must bring a refillable water bottle from home.

### Sunscreen

Every camper must have sunscreen applied before arriving at camp in the morning.

Every camper must bring their own spray sunscreen to camp on their first day to be left at camp.

Spray bottles are preferred. The bottle must be clearly labeled.

Camp staff will direct campers to reapply sunscreen before lunch.

Counselors will monitor sunscreen application and assist campers if needed.
