Campers explore the exciting world of science, technology, engineering, art, and math (STEAM) through building projects, experiments, and design challenges. Sharing ideas, asking questions, and making predictions are encouraged!



Robust outdoor play and structured games help campers learn sportsmanship and develop their physical strength and endurance. Campers learn critical thinking and problem solving by participating in board games and team challenges with their peers.



Campers express themselves by participating in hands-on visual arts, including photography, videography, drawing, and painting. Campers develop planning skills by working on project-based activities with their peers and will participate in group performances or discussions, debates, and other public speaking opportunities.



Social and emotional growth is nurtured through camper- and teacher-led activities that promote a feeling of community and belonging. Campers learn through open-ended activities that give them a chance to apply problem-solving skills and collaborate with friends.

Forms

Please email the camp staff at info@southernhighlandsprep.com if you have any questions regarding required forms. Campers will not be permitted to attend Camp Southern Highlands Preparatory School without the required forms on file.

Payment

One week's tuition is due at the time of enrollment. The deposit will be applied to the final week of camp. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday. A \$25 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday.

Cancellation

If you enroll in camp and your plans change, you can receive a full refund/credit for camp tuition, less registration fee. **Program changes are made by the parent through the camp registration portal only and must be received 2 weeks prior to the camp start date.** Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or who do not cancel two weeks prior to start date, will not receive a refund or credit. By submitting your payment, you are agreeing to the policy outlined above.

Lunch

Campers should bring 2 snacks and a lunch daily. Before care and after care snack will be provided by Camp SoHi. We ask that sugary items be limited. Additionally, please ensure that your camper has a refillable water bottle every day.

Sunscreen

Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to coming to camp and provide a hat they may wear during outside play time (please label the hat with your child's name). Please see policies for sunscreen application on **preschool students**.
